### **Call for applicants, The Works Artist in Residence program**

The Works, Ohio center for History, Art and Technology located in Newark, Ohio [www.attheworks.org](http://www.attheworks.org) is seeking applicants for our Artist in Residence program. There are two residencies available; each is 13 weeks in duration.

Fall 2019: September 24, 2019 through December 21, 2019.

Spring 2020: January 28, 2020 through April 25, 2020.

The focus of the residency is glass blowing. The resident artist will perform daily glass blowing demonstrations, provide glass instruction, and create items for our gift shop and commissioned work during a 5 day workweek, Tuesday through Saturday along with the glass studio manager.

Applicants must be comfortable with public speaking, teaching glass blowing to beginners and explaining hot glass technique. Residents will narrate during solo glass blowing demonstrations and engage museum visitors.

The Artist in Residence is provided with a comfortable, fully furnished apartment, a stipend of up to \$5000.00 for the residency and use of the hot shop for personal work up to 10 hours per week. The Resident Artist will have an exhibition during their residency to showcase their work and have an opportunity to sell during their exhibition. The sales from the exhibition are split 60/40 with The Works.

The Works hot shop has a 300 pound electric furnace, one glory hole, pipe warmer, garage, two annealing ovens, and two fusing/casting kilns. A flame working area is available as well as a 24 inch horizontal grinding mill, a vertical wet belt sander, and a Covington lathe.
