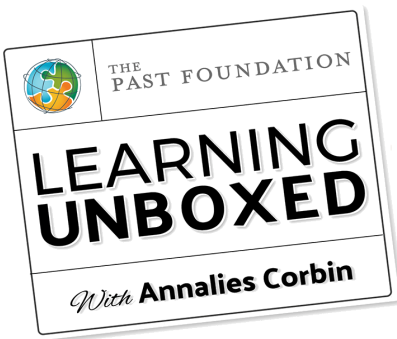
For classroom teachers, curriculum specialists, informal educators, and homeschool educators.
