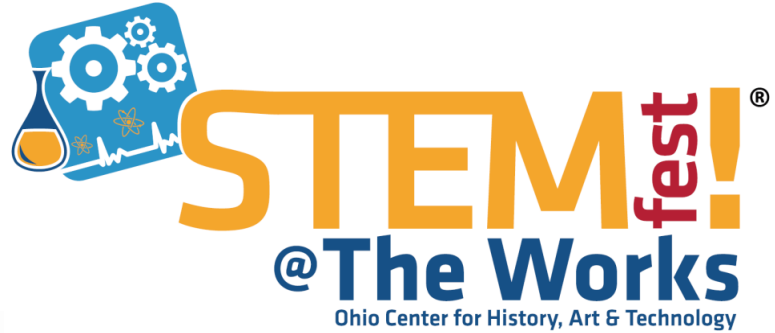


WHAT IS STEMFEST?
